Catechist Training Course Details

The various levels of training for adults are:

- Level I (3-6 year olds)
- Level II (6-9 year olds)
- ◆ Level III (9-12 year olds)

Each course requires 90-120 hours of training including:

- lectures
- presentations
- prayer reflections
- observations

- material making
- ♦ discussion
- planning
- writing album pages

Level I training must be completed prior to Level II and Level III training.

Course Objectives

- To explore the religious potential and characteristics of the
 - ♦ 3-6 year (Level I)
 - ♦ 6-9 year old child (Level II)
- To present the methodology and guiding principles of the Catechesis of the Good Shepherd
- To offer guidelines and assistance in preparing an atrium environment and in making catechist album pages and materials
- To meditate on the scriptural, doctrinal, and liturgical themes presented to the 3-6 year old child
- To broaden the catechist's ability to observe, listen and learn from children
- To deepen the catechist's prayer life and relationship with God
