Ice Breaker

Everyone arranges their chairs in a circle. One person remove their chair from the circle and stand in the middle. Begin by saying "Never have I ever..." about something mom/kid/marriage related. If you HAVE experienced this then you must stand up and switch chairs with someone else who stands up. The person who doesn't get a chair is the new person in the middle.
